We would like to express our sincere gratitude for your support of Frisco Independent School District and the students we serve.

As one of the fastest-growing school districts in the country, Frisco ISD now enrolls more than 58,000 students in 68 schools. Approximately 10 percent of the student population qualifies for free or reduced lunch based on their family income.

While that percentage may seem small, it means there are about 6,000 children in need right here in our community. Many families struggle to put food on the table, and we know hunger can impact a child's ability to learn.

That's why Frisco ISD provides a warm, healthy meal to all students, regardless of the ability to pay. Unlimited fruits and vegetables are available to elementary and middle school children.

Your contribution will pay negative balances incurred by students before they were approved for the free or reduced lunch program. Oftentimes, families face challenges that prevent them from receiving benefits as soon as they are eligible, such as language barriers or a lack of awareness, transportation, or Internet access. Frisco ISD works directly with parents to address outstanding lunch payments and provides information and assistance regarding the free and reduced lunch program
